The **Wolters Kluwer Legal Scholars program**, in its third year, allows current law students to compete for the chance to have their work published in a Wolters Kluwer Legal & Regulatory Solutions U.S. (LRSUS) publication. Wolters Kluwer will accept submissions through Friday, April 1, 2016.

One submission per category may be submitted by any student currently enrolled in an ABA-accredited law school.

Categories for submission are:

- Health law (including Medicare, Medicaid, life sciences, and health reform)
- Cybersecurity (banking and financial privacy, securities, health care, insurance)
- Products liability and consumer safety
- Employment law (including wage/hour, labor, and discrimination)

Depending on the number of entries, one to two winners per category will be selected and published in a Wolters Kluwer publication, to be determined based on the submission's topic.

Winners will be notified by April 22, 2016. The winning submissions will be featured in a Wolters Kluwer publication the week of April 25, 2016, along with a biographical paragraph about the author.
